### **Eligibility:**

demonstrates leadership skills: organized, responsible, trustworthy, enthusiastic, and flexible;

exhibits an interest and willingness to pursue higher leadership roles in Federation;

agrees to share information gained from participation in L.E.A.D.S. with others in the state;

understands and accepts potential expenses involved;

has not held elected positions at or beyond the state level;

has not attended a previous L.E.A.D.S. program.

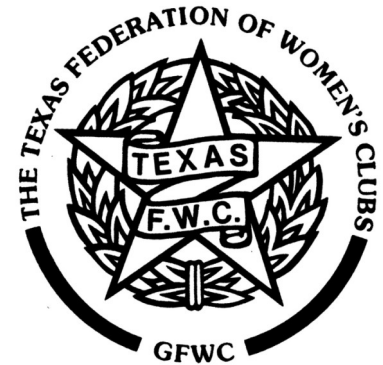
